Bisan holds a webinar entitled Truth and Power

Bisan Center held a webinar entitled "Truth and Power" on Saturday, October 18, 2025, which discussed the dialectic of truth and power.

The webinar included four speakers: Hasan Ladadwa, a lecturer at Birzeit University, who clarified the relationship between truth and power; Hani al-Masri, director of Masarat Center, who reviewed the Palestinian reality; Honida Ghanem, director of Madar Center, who addressed the Israeli reality; and journalist Ahmed Biqawi, who spoke about the role of media in interpreting reality.

Organizing documentation training through social media

Bisan organized a training course on short video production and documentation for social media, in October.

The training aimed to equip participants with the skills to create short videos for social media platforms, showcasing the attacks they experience by settlers and occupation forces, as well as other issues related to them and their communities.
