Bisan concludes a project to protect villages vulnerable to settler attacks

Bisan Center concluded its project to protect vulnerable communities in the West Bank, which focused on equipping residents of several villages in the Nablus, Ramallah, and al-Bireh governorates with skills and providing them with equipment to promote safety in the community. The project comprised three phases: first aid training, training on documenting violations via social media, and finally, the provision safety equipment.

Bisan participates in Olive Conference held by Kadoorie University.

Bisan Cente participated in the Sixth International Scientific Conference on Olives in Palestine, organized by Palestine Technical University – Kadoorie, at its main campus in Tulkarm, on November 24-25, 2025. The conference focused on the suffering of olive farmers and harvesters, particularly the attacks and restrictions imposed on them by settlers. The center's participation included the presentation of two research papers and a film on environmental agriculture.
